### **Courses**


The courses in the department are categorized as theoretical and applied ones. Whilst some of the theoretical courses are Introduction to Translation, Translation

For the computer-assisted translation and technologyoriented courses, a classroom is available to the students.


Applied interpreting courses are taught both in the classrooms
