Furthermore, a wheelchair ramp, an extra wheelchair, and an elevator are available at the faculty entrance to facilitate the access of individuals with special needs.

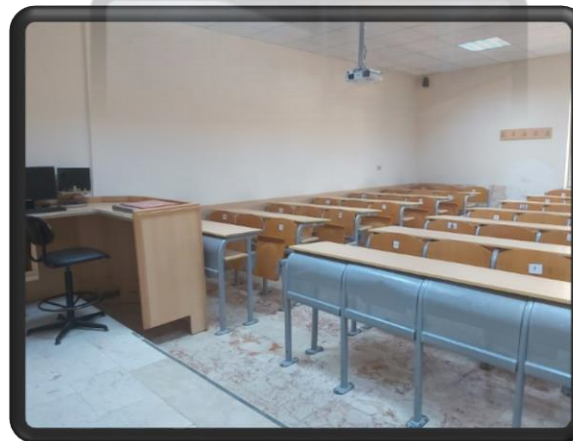
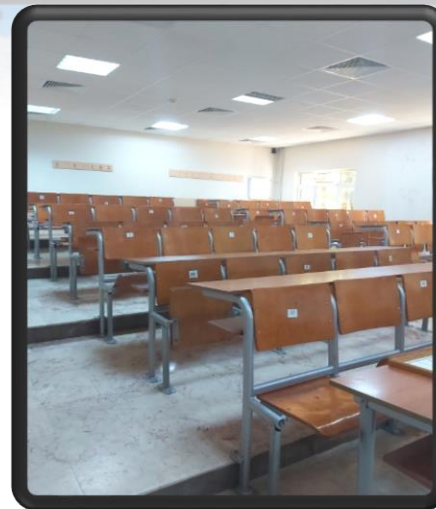
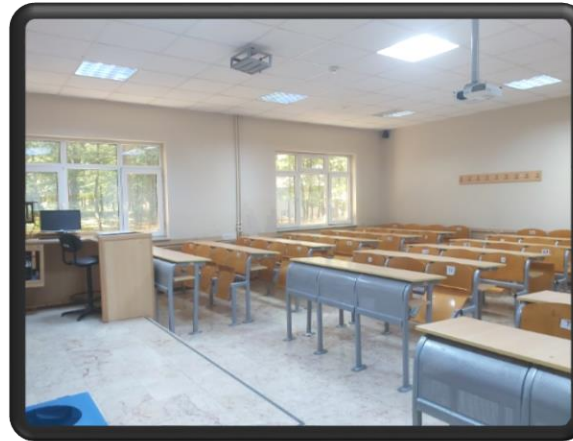

Academic Staff

In addition to the undergraduate programmes (English and German Translation and Interpreting programmes), master's and doctorate programs are offered within the department. The academic staff in the Department of Translation and Interpretation consist of two professors, one associate professor, six assistant professors, four research assistants, and five lecturers.



Courses

The courses in the department are categorized as theoretical and applied ones. Whilst some of the theoretical courses are *Introduction to Translation, Translation Theories, and Translation Methods; Translation Practices and Computer-Assisted Translation* are amongst the applied courses. Six classrooms have been allocated to the department.

Laboratories

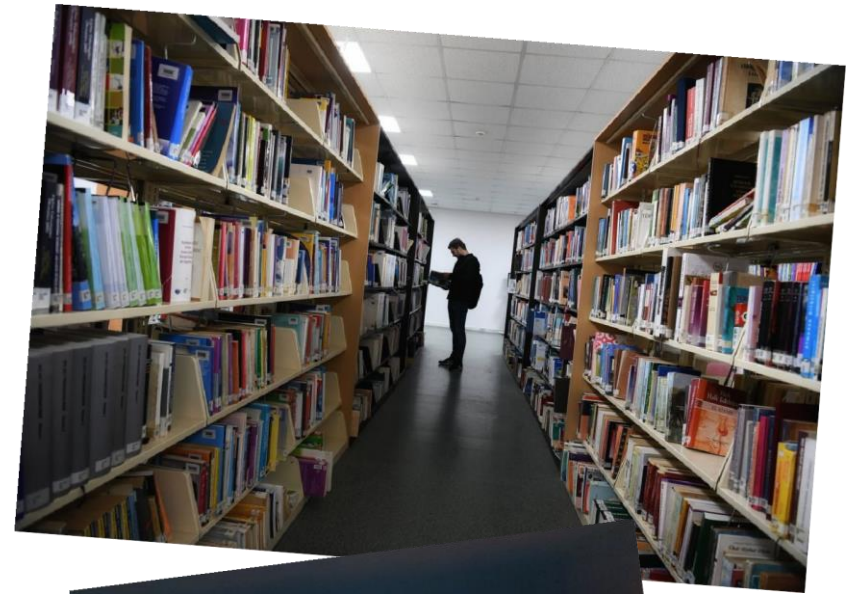
For the computer-assisted translation and technology-oriented courses, a classroom is available to the students. Applied interpreting courses are taught both in the classrooms and in the interpreting laboratory. We are working on obtaining a more advanced laboratory. The students are required to do an internship at the end of the sixth semester and complete a final project in the eighth semester.

The Department of Translation and Interpretation has its own small, albeit stacked, library with English and German books and course books. This library is located inside the building.
